



Position Description: Substitute Choir Teacher

Location: Sistema Toronto operates out of three centres across the GTA. The substitute teachers will teach out of one or more of these locations:

- Parkdale - 78 Seaforth Avenue (Queen West and Lansdowne)
- Yorkwoods - 25 Yorkwoods Gate (Jane and Finch)
- Scarborough - 230 Morningside Drive (Lawrence and Morningside)

Organization Description

Sistema Toronto provides free ensemble-based music lessons as part of an intensive social program that inspires at-risk kids to reach their full potential as students, musicians and citizens. Sistema Toronto currently serves 275 students in the communities of Parkdale, Jane-Finch and East Scarborough.

Position Description

Sistema Toronto teachers work closely with students to develop their musical abilities as well as build life skills like empathy, hard work, trust and kindness.

The Choir Teacher will work with choirs at our Parkdale and Yorkwoods centres on proper vocal production techniques (posture, breathing, pitch matching, etc.) and work on repertoire for performances. Sistema Toronto is a social program, so the Choir Teacher will also be expected to help students develop skills like listening, team work, and confidence.

Students are ages 7 – 12 and are divided into Junior and Senior choirs. Classrooms are equipped with a piano.

Sistema Toronto Choir Teachers plan and execute their own lessons with support from the Executive Director. Sistema Toronto teachers are encouraged to be creative and bring their own teaching styles and ideas into the classroom.

Requirements

This position is suited for an enthusiastic, highly-motivated and naturally communicative individual with experience working with children. We are looking for a candidate who has a

strong musical background and performance ability as well as educational experience. The ability to work cooperatively and flexibly with a busy teaching team are essential assets.
